Individuals receiving this notice shall not be made a party or interested party solely on the basis of this notice.

Notes on Use

A permanency hearing for juveniles placed out of the home shall be held within 12 months from the date of the first removal, and at least every 12 months thereafter. The statute provides who shall receive notice, as listed in the form. K.S.A. 38-2365(h). If the juvenile is 14 years of age or older, the juvenile must be given notice of the time and place of the permanency hearing and request the juvenile's participation in the hearing by attendance or by report to the court. K.S.A. 38-2365(h). (Use Form 361.1 to provide notice to the juvenile.)
